Summer Mosquito Control Workshops!

June 2-5, 2015

The goal of these workshops is to provide training necessary to help deal with community mosquito control problems, including NPDES issues. Topics to be covered include mosquito biology, larviciding, adulticiding, pesticide safety, NPDES regulations and public relations. These workshops are open to all interested individuals. The educational portion for all four workshops will be from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Calibration and droplet testing of spray trucks will occur in the afternoon at each site. Grant funds are to be used to assist mosquito control agencies or communities in conducting mosquito control operations. Grants are specifically to be used for equipment, chemical or surveillance purchases. Grant criteria and the application form will be available at our website. The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), under the Clean

Water Act, will be an important aspect of Nebraska mosquito control operations. The NPDES went into effect on November 1, 2011, despite strong political opposition. The NPDES will affect how mosquito control personnel apply adulticides and larvicides, including the use of biological larvicides. The Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has prepared updated Flow Charts, NPDES General Permit information and a Fact Sheet on their website:
