#### <u>Dates Set for the 2008</u> <u>Spring Mosquito Control</u> <u>Workshops</u>

The Nebraska Mosquito and Vector Control Association (NMVCA) will be sponsoring its annual Mosquito Control Workshops in June 2008. The goal of these workshops is to provide training necessary to help deal with community mosquito control problems.

The mosquito control workshops will be held in Lincoln on June 3<sup>th</sup>, in O'Neil on June 4<sup>th</sup>, in Kearney on June 5<sup>th</sup> and Gering on June 6<sup>th</sup>. The educational portion for all four workshops will be from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. A Van Diest sponsored calibration and droplet testing of spray trucks will occur in the afternoon at each site. Registration will begin at 8:30 am. <u>Lunch is included with each registration!</u> The workshops this year will have an emphasis on larviciding and adulticiding mosquito control efforts, techniques and products.

These workshops are open to all interested individuals. Workshop registration fees are listed on the <u>registration form (page 3)</u>. <u>Pre-registration is requested</u> but payment for all fees can be made at the door. All checks must be made <u>payable to the NMVCA</u> and payment must be made no later than the day of the workshop.
