
Dates Set for the 2013 <u>Spring Mosquito Control Workshops!</u>

The goal of these workshops is to provide training necessary to help deal with community mosquito control problems, including NPDES issues. Topics to be covered include mosquito biology, larviciding, adulticiding, pesticide safety, NPDES regulations and public relations. These workshops are open to all interested individuals. The educational portion for all four workshops will be from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Calibration and droplet testing of spray trucks will occur in the afternoon at each site. The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), under the Clean Water Act, will be an important aspect of Nebraska mosquito control operations. The NPDES went into effect on November 1, 2011, despite strong political opposition. The NPDES will affect how mosquito control personnel apply adulticides and larvicides, including the use of biological larvicides. The Nebraska

control personnel apply adulticides and larvicides, including the use of biological larvicides. The Nebrask Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has prepared updated Flow Charts, NPDES General Permit information and a Fact Sheet on their website:
